

L&T-IHI combine bags ₹1,390-cr high-speed rail corridor contract

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THE NATIONAL HIGH Speed Rail Corporation on Monday signed a contract agreement for procurement and fabrication of 28 steel bridges for the Mumbai Ahmedabad High Speed Rail Corridor with Larsen & Toubro-IHI Infrastructure Systems consortium. The contract is worth ₹1,390 crore.

The heavy civil infrastructure business of L&T Construction secured a contract from two packages [P4(X) & P4(Y)] of the MAHSR with ISI of Japan, in January 2021, to procure, fabricate, assemble, paint and The contract is to procure, fabricate, assemble, paint and transport 28 steel bridges

transport 28 bridges — steel truss superstructures with bearings — tovarious sites that will cross over roads/ rivers/railway lines and other structures.

According to Achal Khare, managing director, NHSRCL, the actual construction work has begun for the MAHSR corridor and matters are taking shape. This is the third significant contract awarded by NHSRCL for the project.
