- c) That during execution of the Contract, if awarded, the Licensor company shall provide technical guidance to the Licensee company in the

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design, manufacture, and quality control of the Inspection and Maintenance Cars covered under the Contract.

- d) That the License Agreement between the Licensor company and the Licensee company is valid as on the date of Bid submission for subject Work, and shall remain valid and in force until the completion of the Contract,
